Participants will learn how well-designed policies promote legal compliance, operational consistency, sound decision-making, and risk management while helping reduce organizational liability.

INSTRUCTIONAL AREAS

IMPORTANCE OF POLICY

Effective policy is the foundation for defining authority and responsibility, guiding staff, promoting legal compliance and best practices while avoiding common policy pitfalls.

LEGAL LIABILITY IMPLICATIONS

Policy relationship to Civil Constitutional Rights, Civil Torts, 42 U.S.C. § 1983, Title VII Employment and Civil Rights Laws, State and Federal Court Rulings, and organizational rules and regulations.

POLICY ASSESSMENT

A systematic approach for evaluating policy related to best practices, laws and regulations, job-task needs, conducting research, and crafting clear, effective, and legally sound policies.

ADMINISTRATION & COMPLIANCE

Strategies for compiling, distributing, and maintaining current policy management systems, retention of outdated policies, promoting accountability and compliance, and initiating effective policy training.

PRACTICAL APPLICATION

Students will be given an opportunity to research, assess, and develop policy during the course and present their findings to the class.
